


VBS attendees are ages 3 years and up. Please pray about helping with this outreach program and invite your family and friends to attend Vacation Bible School.

3 weeks ago we did a training for all camp teams. We had 113 people signed from 13 different teams and churches.

We have teams from 6 different denominations and 1 non-denominational church. It is great to see that we can still for the same goal: Reaching young people for Christ. I am praying that this cooperation of Christian churches in Slovakia will continue now as we all will be helping refugees fleeing from Ukraine.

We had very good feedback about the training and many teams were able to prepare better for the

season that is ahead. We are praying that situation in Slovakia will continue to be safe and we will be able to do 13 camps in the summer as we are planning and most importantly that we will see God changing the hearts of young people.

First, we had these 2 women stay with us for a short time. Their names are Zoja and Kamila, the mother and her daughter. They left their hometown in Charkiv because of war and travel multiple days to get out. I am glad we were able to help a little bit the refugees coming to Slovakia.

Thanks to God they are safe now in Slovakia, but we are all praying the war in Ukraine will

be over soon.

Right after they left I was sick for almost 2 weeks straight and barely managed to be part of our annual Conference for youth leaders. It was a blessing to have this conference even during tricky times in our country. During the conference, I was able to meet 2 people online for a mentoring session and it is always so encouraging to see how passionate they are.

Pray for the next generation of Christian leaders in Slovakia.

Just wanted to let you know that even though we are living close to the Ukraine borders in Slovakia it is still very safe and we are more concerned about how to help our brothers. But you can continue to pray for stopping the war and also for safety in Slovakia to continue.
