We're already into October of this year! Wednesday evening we are discussing a study by Pastor John Piper called "What Jesus Demands of the World". We have had excellent discussions and we would like to add you to the group (6:30-7:30 pm).

We are grateful for Pastor Lee returning to our pulpit generally on the 4th Sunday of each month. This October for the first 3 Sundays we will follow the theme: "Enter God's Rest" based upon Genesis 2:18-25; Amos 5:6-7, 10-15; Ecclesiastes 5:10-20.
